He served as assistant to Boston Pops Principal Conductor and composer John Williams from 1989 to 1993. Feldman joined the Longwood Symphony Orchestra as Music Director in July 2012. This season marked his final as music director; we are incredibly grateful for his ten years of artistic leadership!






